Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Our Lord Jesus cares far more about what is in our hearts than anything else, and what He desires most is a living, persevering faith. Last week's Gospel showed Peter sinking not because of who he was, but because fear overtook his faith. Jesus reached out His hand, reminding us that what matters most is the heart that trusts God even in the storm. Today's Scriptures continue that same message. Faith — not race, not ancestry, not birthplace, not culture, not social status — is what opens the door to God's grace. The Canaanite woman shows us that Jesus looks past every human barrier and sees the heart that believes.

In every age, the evil one works tirelessly to manufacture divisions among God's people, creating false perceptions that race, origin of birth, language, or differing beliefs should separate us. These divisions are not from God; they are spiritual distractions meant to keep us suspicious of one another and distant from the unity Christ desires. Sometimes these divisions are even perpetuated by public officials, who make shocking and dehumanizing accusations about immigrants — claims so outrageous that we struggle to understand how anyone in authority could speak such things. Yet this is precisely how the evil one sows confusion: by using fear, exaggeration, and falsehood to turn hearts against one another.

Christ calls us to something higher. He calls us to love in spite of our differences, to see the person before the label, and to recognize every human being as a child of God. Faith destroys the lies of division. Faith unites what the world tries to fracture. Faith allows us to see one another as brothers and sisters created in God's image. When our hearts are rooted in faith, the manufactured boundaries of the world lose their power, and we become the "house of prayer for all peoples" that God Himself envisions.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Nuestro Señor Jesús se preocupa mucho más por lo que hay en nuestro corazón que por cualquier otra cosa, y lo que más desea es una fe viva y perseverante. El Evangelio de la semana pasada mostró a Pedro hundiéndose no por quién era, sino porque el miedo se apoderó de su fe. Jesús extendió la mano, recordándonos que lo que más importa es el corazón que confía en Dios incluso en medio de la tormenta. Las Escrituras de hoy continúan con ese mismo mensaje. La fe — ni la raza, ni la ascendencia, ni el lugar de nacimiento, ni la cultura, ni el estatus social — es lo que abre la puerta a la gracia de Dios. La mujer cananea nos muestra que Jesús mira más allá de cada barrera humana y ve el corazón que cree.

En cada época, el malvado trabaja incansablemente para fabricar divisiones entre el pueblo de Dios, creando falsas percepciones de que la raza, el origen de nacimiento, el idioma o creencias diferentes deberían separarnos. Estas divisiones no provienen de Dios; son distracciones espirituales destinadas a mantenernos desconfiados unos de otros y alejados de la unidad que Cristo desea. A veces estas divisiones incluso las perpetúan los funcionarios públicos, que hacen acusaciones impactantes y deshumanizadoras sobre los inmigrantes — afirmaciones tan escandalosas que nos cuesta entender cómo alguien con autoridad podría decir tales cosas. Sin embargo, así es precisamente como el malvado siembra confusión: usando el miedo, la exageración y la falsedad para volver los corazones unos contra otros.

Cristo nos llama a algo más alto. Nos llama a amar a pesar de nuestras diferencias, a ver a la persona ante la etiqueta y a reconocer a cada ser humano como hijo de Dios. La fe destruye las mentiras de la división. La fe une lo que el mundo intenta fracturar. La fe nos permite vernos unos a otros como hermanos y hermanas creados a imagen de Dios. Cuando nuestros corazones están arraigados en la fe, los límites fabricados del mundo pierden su fuerza y nos convertimos en la "casa de oración para todos los pueblos" que Dios mismo imagina.

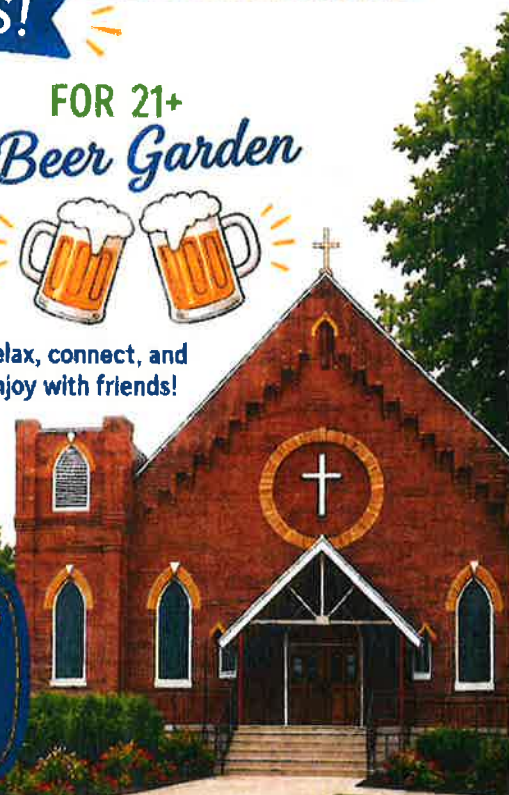

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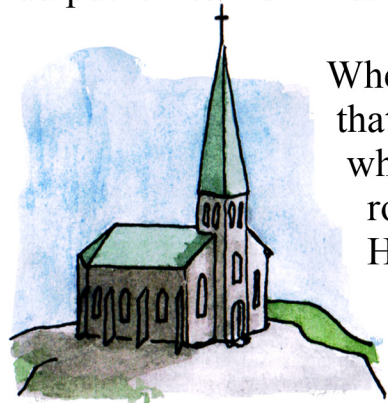
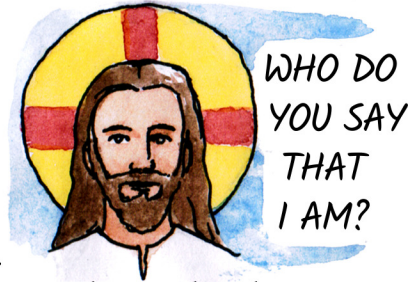

"You Are Peter."

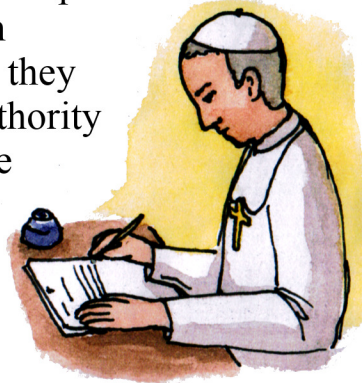
Today in the Gospel reading, Jesus asked His disciples who people thought that He was. Everybody seemed to think He was someone special, but none of them knew who He really was.
