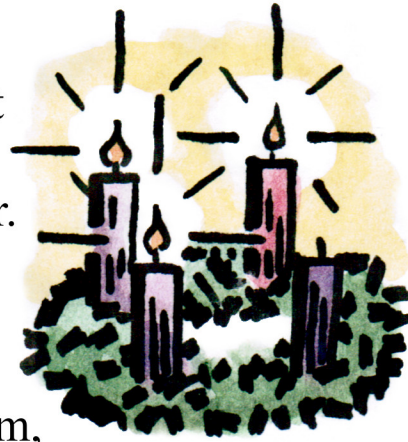


# Painting the Way to Jesus

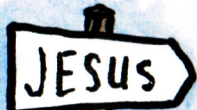
