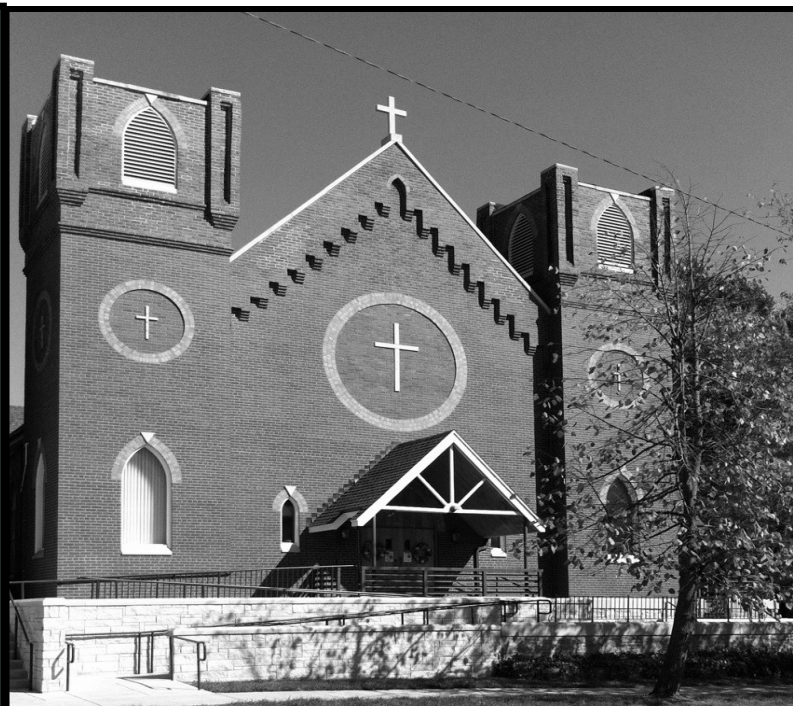

### Shroud of Turin Display Replica of the Burial Cloth of Jesus

The Shroud of Turin, also known as the Holy Shroud, is a length of the linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a man. It has been venerated for centuries, especially by members of the Catholic Church, as the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus after his crucifixion, and upon which Jesus's bodily image is miraculously imprinted.

A replica of the Shroud of Turin will be on display for the next two weeks in the parish hall. The hall will be open to the public during office hours (Monday-Friday 12:30pm-4pm) and during PSR Class (Wednesday 7pm-8pm and Sunday 11am-12pm)
