Deacon Elect Jim**

Dear Brother and Sisters,

As many of you know, I will be ordained to the Sacred Order of Deacons this coming Saturday. Denise and I are profoundly honored to serve this parish. Our love and affection for this community are deep and heartfelt, and we are grateful for the prayers and support you have offered throughout my formation.

My journey toward ordination has been shaped by the four pillars of diaconal formation: Human, Spiritual, Intellectual, and Pastoral. These dimensions have formed not only my understanding of ministry but also my heart for service. Human formation has taught me to grow in compassion and integrity; spiritual formation has deepened my relationship with Christ; intellectual formation has strengthened my understanding of the faith; and pastoral formation has prepared me to serve you with humility and dedication.

The word deacon comes from the Greek diakonos, meaning servant. My vocation is rooted in service—service to God, to the Church, and to all of you. While a deacon is an ordained minister, my role is distinct from that of the priest. The priest presides at Mass; I assist him and serve the community in ways that reflect the heart of the diaconate.

One of my primary responsibilities will be the proclamation of the Gospel. As the ordinary minister of the Gospel, it is my duty to proclaim it whenever I am present at Mass, unless there is a serious reason not to. This is one of the most visible signs of the ministry entrusted to me.

During the Penitential Act, you may also see me lead the Kyrie (“Lord, have mercy”), helping guide our community in prayer as we prepare to celebrate the sacred mysteries.

I will serve as the Deacon of the Chalice, which includes preparing the Precious Blood, assisting the priest at the altar, and elevating the chalice during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. This is a profound privilege and a central part of my liturgical service.

In addition to my liturgical duties, I will also be able to witness marriages, baptize, preside at funerals, and offer blessings in a canonical and proper way as entrusted by the Church.

Many people have asked how they should address me. Jim is perfectly fine, Deacon Jim is good too—but if you call me Mr. Haston, I’ll probably look around for my dad.

You may also see me assisting with the preparation of the gifts, helping distribute Holy Communion, offering certain liturgical invitations such as the Sign of Peace, and dismissing the assembly at the end of Mass.

Denise and I are deeply grateful for the love, support, and encouragement you have shown us. We look forward to serving you with devotion and humility, and we hold each of you in our prayers as we begin this new chapter of ministry.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Como muchos sabéis, seré ordenado a la Sagrada Orden de los Diáconos este próximo sábado. Denise y yo estamos profundamente honrados de servir a esta parroquia. Nuestro amor y afecto por esta comunidad son profundos y sinceros, y estamos agradecidos por las oraciones y el apoyo que me habéis brindado a lo largo de mi formación.

Mi camino hacia la ordenación ha sido moldeado por los cuatro pilares de la formación diaconal: Humano, Espiritual, Intelectual y Pastoral. Estas dimensiones han formado no solo mi comprensión del ministerio, sino también mi corazón para el servicio. La formación humana me ha enseñado a crecer en compasión e integridad; la formación espiritual ha profundizado mi relación con Cristo; la formación intelectual ha fortalecido mi comprensión de la fe; Y la formación pastoral me ha preparado para servir con humildad y dedicación.

La palabra diácono proviene del griego diakonos, que significa siervo. Mi vocación está arraigada en el servicio: el servicio a Dios, a la Iglesia y a todos vosotros. Aunque un diácono es un ministro ordenado, mi papel es distinto del del sacerdote. El sacerdote preside la misa; Le ayudo y sirvo a la comunidad de maneras que reflejan el corazón del diaconado.

Una de mis responsabilidades principales será la proclamación del Evangelio. Como ministro ordinario del Evangelio, es mi deber proclamarlo siempre que estoy presente en la Misa, salvo que haya una razón seria para no hacerlo. Esta es una de las señales más visibles del ministerio que me han confiado.

Durante la Ley Penitencial, también puede que me veas liderar el Kyrie ("Señor, ten piedad"), ayudando a guiar a nuestra comunidad en la oración mientras nos preparamos para celebrar los misterios sagrados.

Serviré como Diácono del Cáliz, lo que incluye preparar la Preciosa Sangre, asistir al sacerdote en el altar y elevar el cáliz durante la Liturgia de la Eucaristía. Este es un privilegio profundo y una parte central de mi servicio litúrgico.

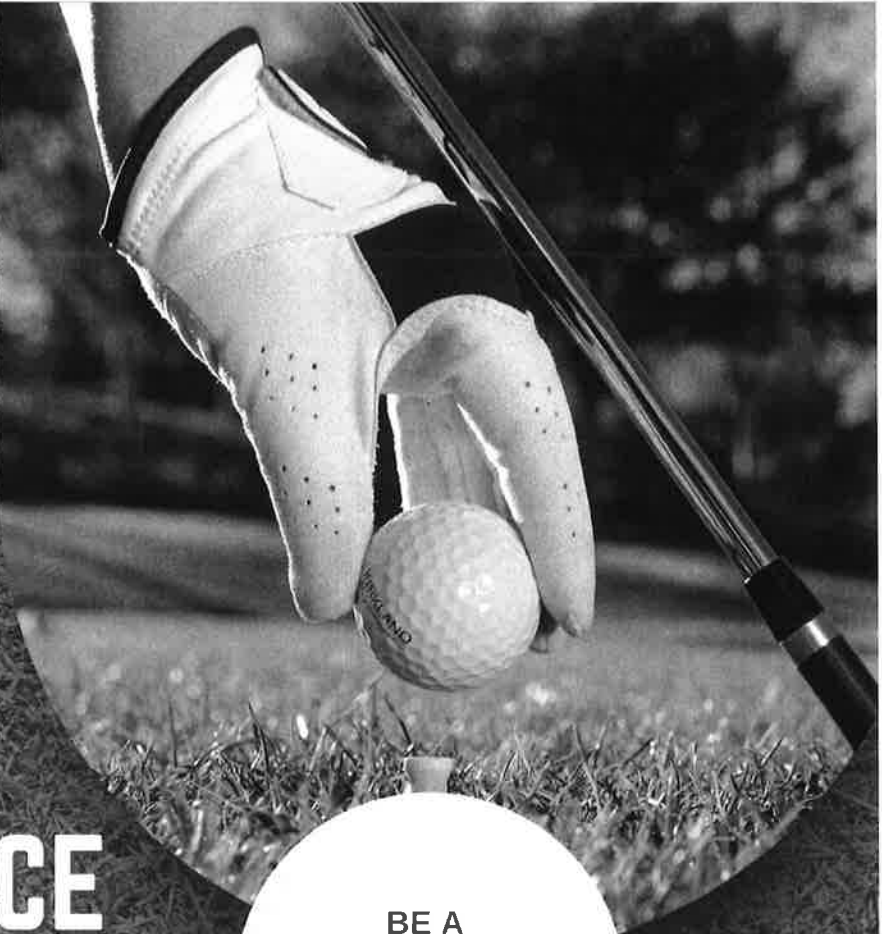
Además de mis deberes litúrgicos, también podré presenciar matrimonios, bautizar, presidir funerales y ofrecer bendiciones de manera canónica y adecuada, tal y como lo confie la Iglesia.

Mucha gente me ha preguntado cómo deberían dirigirse a mí. Jim está perfectamente bien, Deacon Jim también es bueno—pero si me llamas señor Haston, probablemente buscaré a mi padre.
