To the Choirs, who always were willing to play when I needed music for liturgy celebrations.

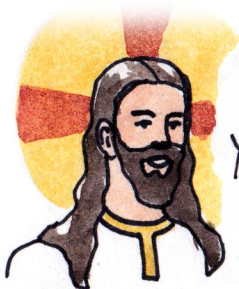
St Lawrence parish is blessed with all these wonderful volunteers.

Labourers in the Harvest

Luke 10:1-12, 17-20



I am sending
you out as lambs
in the midst
of wolves.

In today's Gospel
reading, Jesus sends
out seventy-two dis-
ciples to tell the people in

the towns that He is coming, and to heal the sick. He tells them that they should pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest.

Jesus compares the souls of the people to a harvest. He needs people who will go out into the world and gather the souls for Him, and tells the people that they should pray that God will send out these labourers. Do you know who these people are? They are the priests and other missionaries who work to bring people to Jesus.
