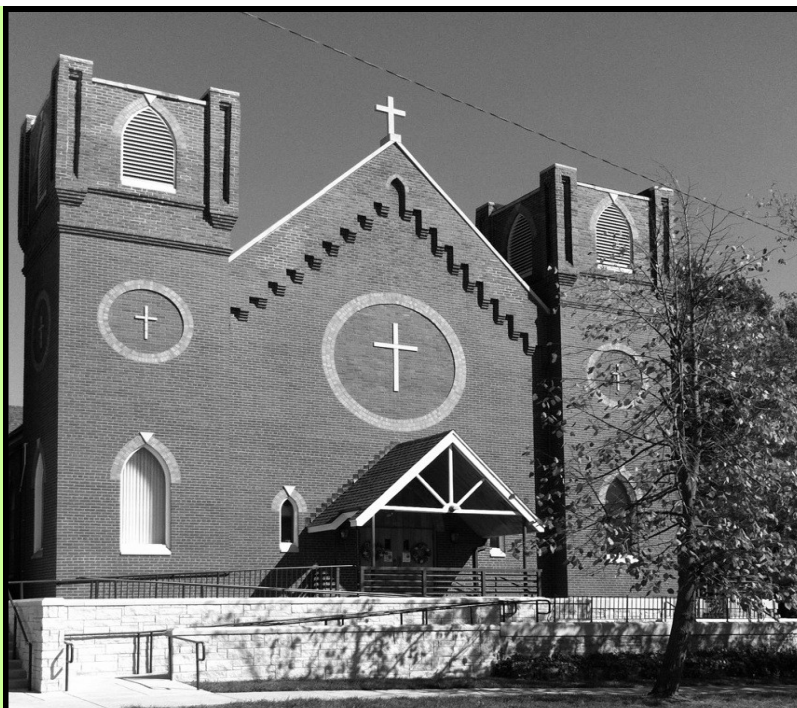

Bishop Edward Rice issues St. Patrick’s Day Dispensation. The law of abstinence binds those Catholics who have completed the 14th year of their age. In 2023, the Memorial of Saint Patrick’s Day falls on Fri., Mar., 17, during the Third Week of Lent. Bishop Edward Rice therefore decrees that on Fri., Mar. 17, 2023, all Catholics of the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau, no matter where they may be, by his authority, dispensed from the obligation.

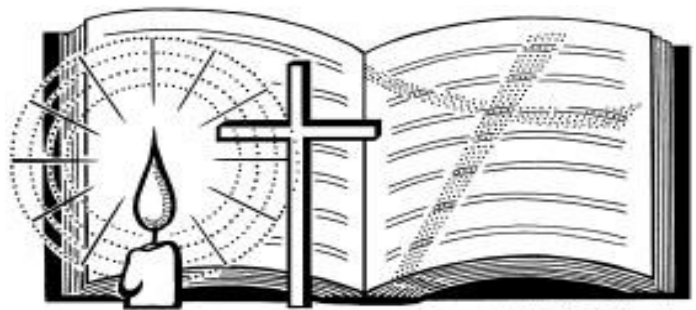

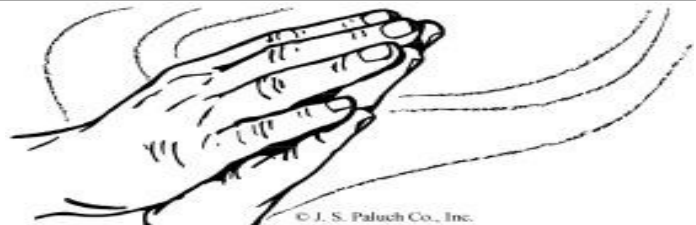

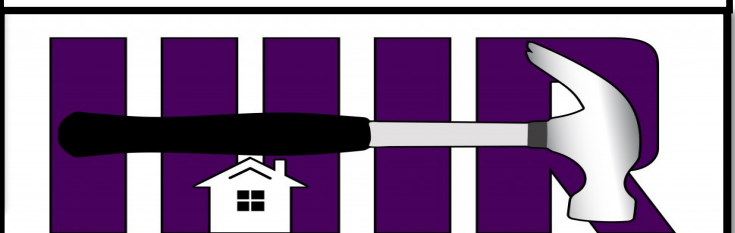
