4. Guardarás los días de precepto. Esto requiere que se complete la observancia dominical mediante la participación en las principales fiestas litúrgicas que guardan los misterios del Señor, de la Virgen María y de los santos. Requiere, también, la abstinencia de aquellos trabajos, y asuntos que impiden la adoración que se ha de rendir a Dios, el gozo que es propio del Día del Señor, o el descanso apropiado de la mente y el cuerpo.
5. Observar el día prescrito de ayuno y abstinencia. Esto asegura los tiempos de ascesis (propia-disciplina) y penitencia que nos prepara para las fiestas litúrgicas; Nos ayudan a adquirir libertad de corazón y dominio sobre nuestros instintos.
6. Proveer a las necesidades materiales de la Iglesia. Esto requiere que los fieles contribuyan a la Iglesia de acuerdo con sus capacidades.

Parents of the PSR

To all the parents thank you so much for taking your time on bringing your sons and daughters to learn about God, sacraments, and laws of the Church. And we all know what those are, Laws:

1. You shall attend Mass on Sundays, and all Holy days of obligation. This requires us to participate in the Eucharist celebration, when the community gathers on the day commemorating the resurrection of the Lord.
2. You should confess your sins at least once a year. This ensures preparation for the Eucharist y the reception of the sacrament of Reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness. *
3. You shall humbly receive your Creator holy Communion at Least during the Easter season. This precept guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's body and blood in connection with the Paschal feast, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy.
4. You shall keep the days of Obligation. This requires the completion of the Sunday observance by participation in the principal liturgical feasts that hooor the mysteries of the Lord, the Virgin Mary, and the saints. It requires, also, abstinence from those labors and business concerns impede the worship to be rendered to God, the joy that is proper to the Lord's Day, or proper relaxation of mind and body.
5. You shala observe the prescribed day of fasting and abstinence. This ensures the times of ascesis (Sel-discipline) and penance that prepares us for the liturgical feasts; they help us acquire freedom of heart and mastery over our instincts.
6. You shall provide for the material needs of the Church. This requires the faithful to contribute to the Church according to their abilities.

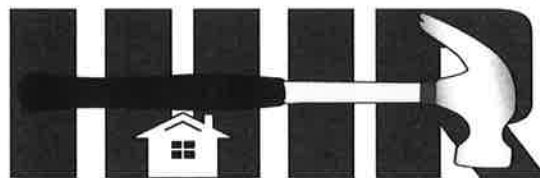
