



Jesus, you are my King and my God and I love you. Help me to be your good servant!







In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus tells the story of a man who showed mercy to someone who was vulnerable and in need. At the end of the parable, Jesus gives us a simple but powerful command: "Go and do likewise" (Luke 10:37). This call to compassion is at the heart of Catholic Charities of Southern Missouri's mission.


