What is something special that you can do today to celebrate the feast of Christ the King?

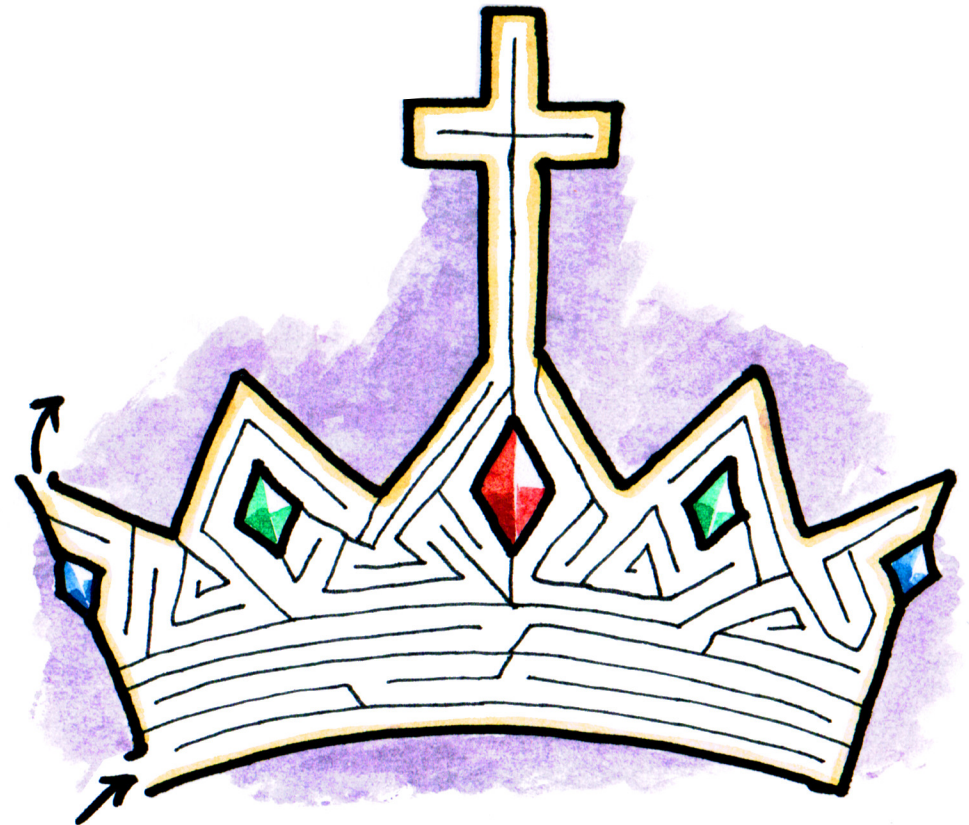
