PARISH HALL MAINTENANCE

The parish hall lights are nearly all burned out and work is proceeding to rewire the units to use LED bulbs that will last well into the future.

- We have an anonymous donation of \$1,260 to update the lights in the southeast corner stairwell – the southwest will also be \$1,260
- The estimate to update the lights in the parish gym is \$4,300, which includes 96+ bulbs, equipment, and labor – we have received donations of \$4,100 toward this!!
- The lights above the stairs leading to the upper classrooms need to be replaced - this will be done for the cost of the bulbs
- **We are seeking additional donations to help cover these expenses!**

Other repairs:

- A breaker in the parish kitchen was updated by Brett Dierker and Al Dohmen, saving us the \$660 estimated for that repair
- The large, badly damaged tree in the school yard was removed by several parish volunteers, saving us the \$3,500 estimated by a local tree service
- 3 other damaged trees also need to be removed – **we are checking to see if the city can remove them in a timely manner**
