Dear Friends,

“Will you come and follow me if I but call your name... Will you go where you don’t know... will you leave yourself behind... will you turn and follow me and never be the same.” These words from “The Summons” offer the opportunity to discern a vocation to the priesthood and religious life.

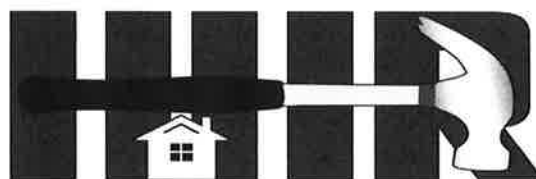
