World Mission Sunday 2024

World Mission Sunday, for support of Missions and missionaries of the world, will be celebrated on Sun., Oct. 20, 2024. This collection is a unique, global effort for the entire Church to help build up all aspects of the Church throughout the world. Through the work of these churches, and their witness to Christ, those in need receive practical help and experience God’s love, mercy, hope and peace. This is a parish collection of the missionary work of the Church through the world.

All checks must be written to your parish.

Vote No on Amendment 3

Amendment 3 will appear on Missouri’s November ballot. If passed, it will eliminate parental notification or consent, put women at risk because a medical doctor is not required to approve or perform abortions, and open the door to a taxpayer– funded abortions. Below is the updated court ordered fair ballot language regarding Amendment 3:

A “yes” vote establishes a constitutional right to make decisions about reproductive health care, including abortion and contraceptives, with any governmental interference of that right presumed invalid; removes Missouri’s ban on abortion; allows regulation of reproductive health care to improve or maintain the health of the patient; requires the government not to discriminate; in government programs, funding and other activities, against persons providing or obtaining reproductive health care; and allows abortion to be restricted or banned after Fetal Viability except to protect the life of health of the women.

A “no” vote will continue the statutory prohibition of abortion in Missouri.

We urge all Missourians of good will to advocate for the health and safety of women and their pre-born children and VOTE NO on Amendment

3.

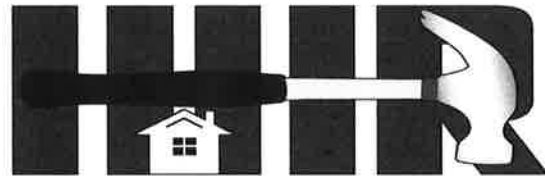

Transforming society to respect and protect all innocent human life.

10 Reasons to DECLINE to Sign

1 Parental Consent laws will be eliminated

If a “right” to abortion is enshrined in our Missouri Constitution it would allow abortions to be performed on pregnant minors without notice to or consent from the minor’s parents.

2 Partial-birth / Late-term abortions on demand

If our Missouri Constitution is amended with a “right” to abortion, abortion will be allowed from conception to live birth, including partial-birth / late-term abortions.

3 Abortion - all 9 months

If this amendment passes, abortions will be allowed for “physical or mental health” reasons all 9 months - from conception to live birth.

4 Health & Safety standards eliminated

Missouri law requires health and safety standards for abortion clinics. These would be eliminated if this amendment passes, and would allow anyone to perform abortions without a healthcare license.

5 MO’s 52+ pro-life laws will be eliminated

Our Missouri Constitution is our state’s supreme (highest) law and governing document. Our pro-life laws will be eliminated by enshrining a “right” to abortion in our Missouri Constitution.

6 Women lose ability to sue for malpractice

A woman’s ability to seek criminal prosecution/civil penalty of any person who performs/assists/provides support to induce/seek/obtain an abortion will be eliminated.

7 PRCs forced to refer for abortion

Pregnancy Resource Centers will be forced to refer for abortion.

8 Ultrasounds eliminated

Abortion clinics will no longer be required to offer or show a mother her baby’s ultrasound image.

9 Significant \$ Loss to MO

Missouri could suffer a significant loss to state and local revenue if this language is enshrined in the Missouri Constitution.

10 Taxpayer-funded abortion

If abortion is enshrined as a “right” in our Missouri Constitution, your legislator will be unable to refuse to appropriate funds to abortion providers.
