Herald Street
Reflection on Bishop Rice's Day of Recollection

Dear Brothers and Sister:

Father Rahab and I attended Bishop Rice's Day of Recollection with many of the clergy from the west side of the diocese, and the day was grace-filled from beginning to end. It began with quiet Adoration, a time to enter prayer and listen for the Lord in the silence. That prayerful stillness prepared us well for Mr. Ben Darnell's excellent talk on living as Catholic Christians in a post-Christendom society. While the phrase "post-Christian" can sound unsettling, his message was ultimately hopeful: many young people are searching for something deeper than the empty promises of status, pleasure, materialism, and relativism. Even in small, grassroots ways we are seeing a quiet resurgence of young hearts longing for truth, beauty, and a faith that gives life purpose.

For me, reclaiming attention looks like practical steps: putting down YouTube more often, picking up a worthwhile book, and allowing silence to shape both prayer and thought. These small sacrifices are not a rejection of wholesome joys but a reordering of priorities so that what forms us—prayer, service, and relationship with God—comes first. As a deacon who struggles with distraction, I find that spiritual growth often begins with these small, concrete choices to recover the discipline of attention.

Mr. Darnell connected this renewal to the seminary's propaedeutic year—an intentional season of prayer, personal growth, and withdrawal from worldly noise so that deeper formation can take root. That emphasis on creating space—stepping back from electronic media, social media, and constant distraction—struck me personally and offered a model parish life might learn from.

Post-Christendom does not frighten me; it deepens my desire to pray for those who have drifted from faith, especially among our own families and community. Prayer matters, and so does a gentle invitation: to Mass, to a parish gathering, or simply to pray together. Our task is to invite with love and trust the response to the Holy Spirit.

A short prayer: Lord, help us notice what distracts us, give us the courage to set it aside, and grant us the humility to invite others to You. Amen.

Reflexión de Herald Street
sobre el Día de la Memoria del obispo Rice
por Deacon Jim,
5 de septiembre de 2026

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

El padre Rahab y yo asistimos al Día de la Reunión del obispo Rice con muchos clérigos del lado oeste de la diócesis, y el día estuvo lleno de gracia de principio a fin. Comenzó con una adoración silenciosa, un momento para entrar en la oración y escuchar al Señor en el silencio. Esa quietud orante nos preparó bien para la excelente charla del señor Ben Darnell sobre vivir como cristianos católicos en una sociedad poscristiana. Aunque la expresión "postcristiano" pueda sonar inquietante, su mensaje fue en última instancia esperanzador: muchos jóvenes buscan algo más profundo que las promesas vacías de estatus, placer, materialismo y relativismo. Incluso de formas pequeñas y de base estamos viendo un resurgimiento silencioso de corazones jóvenes que anhelan la verdad, la belleza y una fe que dé sentido a la vida.

Para mí, recuperar la atención se parece a pasos prácticos: dejar YouTube más a menudo, coger un libro que valga la pena y permitir que el silencio moldee tanto la oración como el pensamiento. Estos pequeños sacrificios no son un rechazo de alegrías saludables, sino un reordenamiento de prioridades para que lo que nos forma —la oración, el servicio y la relación con Dios— venga primero. Como diácono que lucha con la distracción, encuentro que el crecimiento espiritual a menudo comienza con estas pequeñas y concretas decisiones para recuperar la disciplina de la atención.

El Sr. Darnell conectó esta renovación con el año propedéutico del seminario—una temporada intencionada de oración, crecimiento personal y retiro del ruido mundano para que una formación más profunda pueda echar raíces. Ese énfasis en crear espacio—alejándose de los medios electrónicos, las redes sociales y la constante distracción—me impactó personalmente y ofreció un modelo del que la vida parroquial podría aprender.

La postcristiandad no me asusta; profundiza mi deseo de orar por quienes se han alejado de la fe, especialmente entre nuestras propias familias y comunidad. La oración importa, y también una invitación suave: a misa, a una reunión parroquial o simplemente a orar juntos. Nuestra tarea es invitar con amor y confianza a la respuesta al Espíritu Santo.

Una breve oración: Señor, ayúdanos a notar lo que nos distrae, danos el valor para dejarlo a un lado y concédenos la humildad para invitar a otros a Ti. Amén.
